


**BSK COLLEGE OF EDUCATION (FOR WOMEN)**  
**Feedback Analysis 2020-21**

1. 84.1% students have given response that 85% to 100% syllabus was covered in the class. 44.4% students have given response that teachers prepare for the classes thoroughly. 56.6% students have given the response that teachers prepare for the classes satisfactorily.
2. 85.7% students were satisfied with teachers for communicating properly.
3. 73% of students have given response that performances in assignments are discussed with them.
4. 77.8% students accepted that teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications.
5. 74.6% students were agreed that teacher inform them every time about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.
6. 69.8% of students accepted that the teaching and mentoring process in our institution significantly facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
7. 69.8% students responded that teacher identify their strengths and encourage them in respective areas.
8. 69.8% have responded that teachers are able to identify their weakness and help them to overcome every time.
9. 69.8% students verified that teachers use students centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experience to a great extent.
10. 71.4% student ensured that efforts are made by the institute and teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world work to a great extent.



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11. 68.3% of students responded that institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit, opportunities for students.
12. 60.3% students are strongly agreed that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.
13. 61.9% of students agreed that overall quality of teaching learning process in their institute is very good.
14. 61.9% students have given response for internal evaluation process by teachers as always fair. 22.2% students have even response for same as usually fair.
15. 55.6% students were given excellent for teacher's approach to teaching.
16. 52.4% student strongly agreed that institutions makes effort to engage students in the monitoring review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
17. 50.8% students have given response that mentors give necessary follow up every time.
18. 44.4% students have given response that teachers use ICT tools from 70% to 89%. 25.4% students have given response that teachers use ICT tools above 90%.
19. 41.3% students were strongly agree that institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 49.2% students were agree for same.



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
