1. 84.1 % Students have given response that 85% to 100% syllabus was covered in the class.
2. 52.3 % students have given the response that teachers prepare for the classes satisfactorily.
3. 88.6 % Students were satisfied with teachers for communicating properly.
4. 63.6% of students have given response that performances in assignments are discussed with them.
5. 70.7% students accepted that teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications.
6. 72.7 % students were agreed that teacher inform them every time about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.
7. 50% of students accepted that the teaching and mentoring process in our institution very well facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
8. 72.7 % students respondent that teacher identify their strengths and encourage them in respective areas.
9. 72.7 % have responded that teachers are able to identify their weakness and help them to overcome every time.
10. 54.5% students verified that teachers are students centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experience to a great extent.
11. 70.5% Student ensured that efforts are made by the institute and teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world to a great extent.
12. 61.4% of students responded that institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit, opportunities for students.
13. 61.4 % students are strongly agreed that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.
14. 70.5 % of students agreed that overall quality of teaching learning process in their institute is very good.
15. 65.9 % students have given responses for internal evaluation process by teachers as always fair. 28.1% students have even response for same as usually fair.
16. 54.9% Students strongly agreed that institutions makes effort to engage students in the monitoring review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
17. 63.6% students have given response that mentors give necessary follow up every time.
18. 43.2% students have given response that teachers use ICT tools from 70 to 89%. 22.7% students have given response that teachers use ICT tools above 90%.
19. 56.8% students were strongly agreed that institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 31.3% students were agreeing for same.


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
